The 2012 Toledo Lighthouse Festival will for the first time, offer boat rides to see the inside of the lighthouse and also will offer rides around the lighthouse.

The 9<sup>th</sup> annual Toledo Lighthouse Festival is Toledo's/Northwest Ohio's signature nautical festival with: Summer Songs, Island music; Bboat ride around the lighthouse; Great nautical arts and crafts; Huge Waterfront Silent Auction; Great perch and shrimp; Sand Castle Building; Children's Activities and more...

The festival helps to match grants to fund the \$1.5 million lighthouse restoration. When the architecturally unique 1904 Toledo Lighthouse is restored, there will be four 'Keepers' staying at the lighthouse to clean and to provide public tours. The Toledo Lighthouse is located about five miles north of the shores of Maumee Bay State Park. There is a viewer at the marina where you can get a better close up look at the lighthouse.

New artist/crafters are asked to submit an exhibit picture with your application. Once your application is received you will be called or emailed that the application is accepted. To keep with the 'spirit of the festival', exhibitors are asked to include a nautical theme in their display - this does not mean items must be nautical. You will be located at the artists/crafters village on the shores of the inland lake The artists/crafters area is located between the inland lake and Maumee Bay/Lake Erie. All exhibits are outside near parking and festival activities. You can pull up a vehicle to unload. Toledo Harbor Lighthouse items are encouraged. You are also asked to donate an item to the silent auction.

Toledo Lighthouse display items are encouraged in the display along with an overall nautical display theme.

Eligibility - Nautical Items Preferred; All require - **At least 70% of items created by artist, crafter - Items other than nautical considered. First time exhibitors must submit exhibit picture**

Cost - 12' x 12' space outside space is \$40.00 to May 31, \$45.00 after June 1

Sales Tax - Sales Tax must be charged, as required by law Check In - Check in is from 8:00a.m. to 10:00a.m. Sat. & Sun.

Exhibits - Exhibitor's will provide all furnishings and protect property. Exhibitor assumes full responsibility for loss or damage to his person or property. **Display must remain through festival times**

Parking - There will be parking away from the exhibit
